Goodfellow Terra[®] pressure treated wood products, using MicroPro[®] Micronized Copper Azole (MCA) technology, provide longevity and durability for wood used outdoors, as well as having the lowest environmental footprint of any treated wood product available.

Health Canada's PMRA (Pest Management Regulatory Agency) allows MCA treated wood products be used in above ground, ground contact and freshwater applications but Parks Canada has a history of **NOT** following PMRA Label Use Applications. However, individual Parks have requested more information on the products.
